7 IN THE CASE OF ELLEN HANSEN, AND IN THE CASE OF
8 HEATHER SCAGGS, AND IN THE CASE OF ANNE ALDERSON, AND
9 IN THE CASE OF CYNTHIA MORELAND, AND IN THE CASE OF
10 RICHARD STOWERS.

11 NOW, I'M GOING TO TALK ABOUT CYNTHIA MORELAND
12 AND RICHARD STOWERS AND ANNE ALDERSON IN A COUPLE OF
13 SECONDS, BECAUSE THAT EVIDENCE WAS GIVEN TO YOU FOR A
14 LIMITED PURPOSE, AS YOU MAY REMEMBER, AND WE NEED TO
15 REVIEW THAT, AND REVIEW THE LIMITS OF WHAT YOU MAY
16 CONSIDER THAT EVIDENCE FOR.

17 BUT WE KNOW THAT BULLETS THAT WERE FOUND
18 EITHER IN THE HEADS OR CLOSE BY THE BODIES OF THOSE PEOPLE
19 WERE FIRED FROM PEOPLE'S 11-A.

20 THE EVIDENCE IS INCONTROVERTED, UNCONTROVERTED
21 AT THIS POINT, THAT MOLLIE PURNELL BOUGHT THAT GUN FOR
22 THIS DEFENDANT.

23 SHE BOUGHT IT BEFORE THE DATE OF ANY OF THE
24 MURDERS. SHE BOUGHT IT AT A TIME WHEN THE DEFENDANT
25 WAS ANXIOUS TO GET IT.

26 AND SHE BOUGHT AMMUNITION FOR IT WHICH IS
27 CONSISTENT WITH THE TYPE USED IN THE MURDER OF THESE
28 VICTIMS.
